Faith Formation Volunteer Opportunities

Catechist

- Be trained by the Program Coordinator
- Plan pre-selected lessons
- Lead a small group of students throughout the year

Substitute Catechist

- Be trained by the Program Coordinator
- Be available on class nights to fill in at the last minute
- Plan pre-selected lessons
- Make copies for Catechists as needed

- Call for ministry replacements if needed

Program Assistant

- Check in Hall Monitors and give them their materials
- Make copies for Catechists as needed
- Call for ministry replacements if needed
- Dismiss the students

Hall Monitor

- Monitor building entrances
- Help maintain a quiet and safe atmosphere
- Assist the students as needed
- Collect attendance sheets
- Help shut down and secure the building

Gym Supervisor

- Help maintain a Safe and Secure environment during Faith Formation session
- Arrive 20 minutes before session begins
- Make sure students using the gym are engaged in safe play
- Put away all equipment and turn off lights before leaving

Set Up

- Be available in the late afternoon
- Set up tables and chairs in various rooms throughout the building

Youth EXPO Specific Volunteer Opportunities

Small Group Facilitator

- Facilitate small group discussions and activities as directed by the program coordinator/presenter
- Receive direction and support from the Program Coordinator and other presenters
- Availability needed on the 2nd and 4th Sunday evenings of each month September – April

Confirmation Retreat Volunteer Opportunities

Small Group Facilitator

- Lead a small group of youth with discussions and activities
- Receive direction and support from the Program Coordinator and other presenters

Hospitality Crew

- Prepare and serve snacks and lunch
- Clean up after snacks and lunch
- Receive direction and support from Retreat Leader

Registrar

- Greet and check in youth as they arrive
- Help promote a welcoming atmosphere

Confirmation Prep Volunteer Opportunities

Presenter

- Each presenter will have a predetermined topic, general outline and will offer your presentation 4 times throughout the year
- All presentations will be approved with the program director
- Helps form disciples by instructing them in the faith, praying with them and instilling in them the mission of Jesus Christ
- Prepare them for reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation

Mentor

- Develop and maintain a pastoral relationship with 4-6 candidates
- Guide the Candidates in their faith journey, pray with them and instill in them the mission of Jesus Christ as they prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation
