Fay Connors and Randy Haney are compiling the final list of leadership group candidates for the Leadership Summit. The list will be in a preliminary draft for the next planning meeting with Mark Mogilka.

Mark is asking that at least 10 be under the age of 35.

Mark is asking for each formal group to complete a report for submission and use in the Summit.

The next planning meeting for the Leadership Summit will be held with members of the Strategic Planning Committee on Tuesday, January 11th.

Randy has indicated that in talks with Mark, he is asking for no more than two representatives from each active group within the parish. The exception to this will be full attendance by the parish council, finance council and parish staff.

Data collection of what is required for the Summit in March will be forwarded to Mark as completed over the next few weeks.

A summary of the pew surveys will be published in the bulletin within the next couple of weeks and the purpose of the survey.

3. Parish and Financial Updates

Jordan Ecker has been hired as the new Director of Engagement and Communications.

Laurie Dahlbeck has been hired as the new Administrative Assistant of Office Operations.

Randy indicated that it will take 6-12 months to fully train each of the newly hired individuals.

The search continues for a permanent Facilities Supervisor.

Ron Sailer reported that Bill Bradley has been trying to reconfigure ministry scheduling software to better handle the numerous challenges of volunteer

availability for services, programs, etc. He is now working on Ordinary Time and Easter dates.

Deacon Gordon continues to publish a regular email outlining activity efforts within Pastoral Care.

Randy Haney communicated that the parish continues to be slightly ahead of the revenue budget.
