2. New Parish Council Members

Aleksandra Spiess and Dan Wells were introduced as the newest members of the Pastoral Parish Council.

3. Old Business

A meeting of the Strategic Planning Committee and consultant Mark Mogilka took place on May 10th to help further the construction of the final plan draft. It was obvious that the draft would not be complete for presentation to the Parish Council at the June meeting. Work still needs to be completed with the parish staff and timelines need additional clarity. The pandemic has created shortages and challenges in ordering and receiving the liturgical supplies needed to operate.

Archbishop Hebda is still refraining from allowing distribution of the precious blood until more evidence is presented that interactions between people can be resumed at pre-pandemic levels.

There will be an extra mass to handle first communion celebrations this year.

The school graduation mass will be June 5th.

There have been some possible copyright issues surrounding the video ministries. These are being investigated and addressed.

5. New Business

A discussion took place regarding the promotion of the St. Joseph's Business Guild. This is an organization that promotes Catholic businesses, and offers assistance to Catholics looking for employment. They have regular meetings and are always looking to add to their membership.
